Suggested Operational Guidelines for Parish Cattlemen's Association

The purpose of these guidelines is to assist the parish cattlemen's association officers and board of directors with suggestions for establishing and operating a parish cattlemen's association.

Suggested structure for a new parish organization:

Select a person to serve as temporary president.

Appoint a temporary board of directors selected from cattle producers geographically distributed across the parish.

***Selection criteria for the above mentioned individuals should be active and interested in the Louisiana cattle industry.** The individual should be willing to attend meetings and help work with all functions of the associations.

It is suggested that these officers be elected by December. A December election would allow them to be oriented on LCA policy at the state convention in January. This will also allow them to be published in the Parish Officer Directory in *The Louisiana Cattleman*. Elected officers are as follows: The president, vice president, secretary, treasurer and board of directors. The secretary-treasurer may, in some cases, be the same individual.

Suggested criteria for the president:

An individual able and willing to provide leadership for the parish organization.

The president should preside over and conduct meetings according to accepted parliamentary procedure. The individual should be willing and able to represent the parish at state and district functions of the Louisiana Cattlemen's Association. Examples: LCA Annual Convention in January and LCA District Meetings as necessary. The president should bring any issue to the board of directors meetings to be discussed and the appropriate action taken. The parish president should be willing to organize parish meetings and programs. The meetings can be as needed or quarterly. The president should also organize parish membership drives.

Suggested criteria for the office of the vice president:

Individual should be willing to fill the requirements of president in case of his absence and should be willing to assist the president on a daily basis as needed.

Suggested criteria for the office of secretary:

Someone willing to keep accurate records of parish meetings and functions and send meeting notices. He/She should read the minutes of the previous meeting and prepare and count any votes that may take place. The secretary should send out letters to all members.

Suggested criteria for the office of treasurer:

Someone willing to keep accurate financial records of the association's income and expenditures and act as a custodian of the accounts. He/She should collect dues and assist in the preparation of the budget. Prepare and present financial reports.

Suggested criteria for Board of Directors:

Each parish should be represented by at least two members. These individuals should be willing to work with parish programs and membership. Their decisions on parish policies should reflect that of the members in their area. **It is also suggested** that a parish membership chairman be appointed and the individual should be a respected cattlemen within the parish and someone willing to work towards maintaining current membership and recruitment of new members.

The general responsibility of the above mentioned officers and board of directors are as follows:

Establish and maintain a set of articles and by-laws that govern the operation of the organization. Be committed to promote and enhance the cattle industry of the State of Louisiana.

Each parish organization should establish and maintain regular membership meetings throughout the year.

Recommended meeting schedules are as follows:

Parish officers and board of directors should meet at least on a quarterly basis (every three months)

Parish general membership meetings should be held at east twice per year. The general membership meeting program should be of interest to the general membership and provide educational information.

Assistance with obtaining sponsorship for possible meal functions may be obtained by contacting the LCA office. It is recommended that the LCA officers and elected district vice presidents should be included on the general membership meeting mailing list. It is recommended that the LCA District Vice President should be invited to all parish board of directors meetings.

The LCA District Vice President is selected annually by a vote of the parish within each respective district.

Eligibility for re-election to the LCA district vice presidency should be based on attendance of the meetings LCA board of director meetings and sanctioned events.

Suggested Criteria for the District Vice President: The District Vice-President should establish a relationship with all presidents and secretaries in his/her district. He/She should be placed on the parish mailing list so that the DVP can be current on parish activities. The DVP should remain current on issues

at the state level and be willing to travel and share this information at parish board meetings. The DVP should be willing and able to plan and organize a district in late summer or early fall. The DVP should encourage and assist parish officers on membership retention and new member recruitment and share success stories throughout the district.

A strong and vibrant membership base enables your state to effectively represent all sectors of the beef industry in the regulatory and legislative arena. We realize that it takes a tremendous amount of resources to maintain a strong association. It takes committed cattle producers and associates who make a conscious effort each year to write their membership check.

Membership is not always easy work, however, we know it is a necessity. Membership is everyone’s responsibility and should be a priority in any association’s game plan.

25 Ways to Keep your Members

Here are some tactics to help retain your association members. As you are reading through these suggestions, keep an open mind. They may spur some ideas of your own!

1. Hold regular meetings where members have an open forum to discuss their concerns.
2. Use groups of volunteers for renewal and new member solicitations and personal contact. Go see them! Give your parish officers three people to call or go see each monthly. Remember to ask for the sales!
3. Keep track of dropped members.
4. Don't have dues-have investments! It indicates there is a return.(Payment of membership dues are deductible for most members of a trade association under Section 162 on the Internal Revenue Code as an ordinary or business expense.)
5. Set up a membership retention committee and give it goals to achieve.
6. Issue press releases to local newspapers when having meeting.
7. When "hot" issues come up, call some of your least active members and ask their opinion. They'll be amazed and probably renew.
8. If you're planning new services, such as a feeder calf sale or rye grass co-op, try to introduce it prior to renewal time. Use these functions such as sales or quality assurance programs to plug your association.
9. Have a new member packet. It adds to their comfort zone.
10. Offer associate membership to local businesses. When possible, allow these businesses the opportunity to present their services at meetings.
11. Have a speaker plug you association in their presentations,
12. Develop a speaker's bureau from your membership and arrange opportunities for these individuals to speak at various functions.
13. Get all members involved in some facet of the operation of the association. Involved members do not drop their membership as frequently and this will take some of the duties off the existing members.
14. Set up car pools to get people to attend meetings, especially new members.
15. Let members attend their first meeting free of charge.
16. List names of non-renewals at leadership meetings. Have a "Ten Most Wanted" renewal list.
17. Dig beyond the "never did anything for me before" answer. There is always something more.
18. Remember the accounting term "LIFO"(last in, first out). Pay special attention to those who renewed last during the previous renewal period.
19. Assign an officer to contact a certain number of members each month, just to say "hello".
20. Get spouses active, it helps renewal. Also, get junior cattlemen involved. After all they are our future.
21. Send congratulations to members upon their election or appointment to a leadership position.
22. Get local politicians involved with the association.
23. Get members to attend conventions, meetings, etc. Sponsor educational tours for the group.
24. Conduct exit interviews with dropped members.
25. Be a reason to renew. For many members, the association is leadership. If they perceive that they have a group dedicated, qualified officers, and volunteer leaders, they will probably come back.
