- Commercial Heifers and Steers will be split Brahman influence and Non-Brahman Influence and show by weight. Weight Classes will depend on the number of entries
- Commercial Heifers and Steers will be exhibitor classified and will be verified by show officials at the scales
- Commercial Heifers: NO SHEENS OR HAIR ADDITIVES ALLOWED. Soap and Water ONLY
- Steers can be shown with or without hair
- ❖ Breeding classes will be Brahman and Non-Brahman unless 10 or more of a breed or the breed is sponsored.
- Miniature Cattle will be separated by Brahman or Non-Brahman unless there are 10 or more of a breed or the breed is sponsored
- * Registered Heifers are NOT eligible to show in Commercial classes
- Registration papers must be presented day of show, Papers pending will be accepted
- All bulls MUST have nose ring
- Show Management and Judges decisions are final
- Follow LSU Rules unless otherwise stated

- All registered dairy animals older than 6 months of age must be dehorned or be naturally polled. Horn scurs are allowed
- Any dairy animals in a class younger than the senior 2-year-old cow class that have calved will automatically be moved to the senior 2-year-old cow class
- Commercial Dairy Heifers that have not calved will be weighed. Classes will be determined by the range of weights of heifers
- Commercial Dairy Cows will show together
- Show Management and Judges decisions are final
- Follow LSU Rules unless otherwise stated
