ELIGIBILITY RULES FOR LCA QUEEN CONTESTANTS

The following eligibility rules have been established for all contestants. All parish cattlemen's associations are urged to hold a contest in their parish and send their representative to the annual Louisiana Cattlemen's Association convention to compete for the state cattlemen's Queen title.

- 1. All contestants must be:
 - a. Not Married
 - b. There will be no minimum age of the Parish Queens. It is left up to the parishes themselves to determining if a Queen is old enough to represent them.
 - c. Maximum age is 22 years of age or still enrolled in college.
 - d. Must be a member of either LCA or LJCA
 - e. Able to attend the annual Louisiana Cattlemen's Association convention as well as other required activities throughout the year.
 - f. Able to give her full time for promotional activities during promotional activities during the entire year.
 - g. Knowledgeable about the beef industry and LCA.
- 2. Contestants shall not be a Queen of any other agricultural commodity or association.
- 3. Each parish cattlemen's association may sponsor and send one contestant to the LCA convention and Queen's contest.
- 4. Contestants shall pay their own miscellaneous expenses during the LCA convention. Parish associations sponsoring a contestant may elect to pay part or all her miscellaneous expenses if they so desire. This would be above the \$200.00 entry fee that pays for the hotel expenses and most of the major meals. The entry fee payment should accompany the completed LCA Queen's Contest Parish Association Secretary Form, the LCA Queen's Contest Application Form, and include an 8"x10" glossy photograph (head shot.)
- 5. LCA will assist in payment of expenses for the Queen for promotional activities and appearances requested by LCA.
- 6. Judging of contestants will be based on (1) Knowledge, (2) Personality, (3) Speaking Ability, and (4) Poise.
- 7. Each local parish association shall conduct their own contest as they see fit. At their option, a parish association may appoint a contestant rather than select one by means of a parish contest. This action, however, should agree with the entire membership of the parish association.
- 8. The name of contestant, plus a completed LCA Queen Contestant Application Form, and an 8"x10" glossy photograph, plus the Parish Secretary Form should be submitted with the \$200.00 entry fee to: Louisiana Cattlemen's Association, 4921 I-10 Frontage Road, Port Allen, LA 70767. 2021 QUEEN CONTEST EXPLAINATION OF SCORING

KNOWLEDGE OF INDUSTRY AND ASSOCIATION: (1-40 POINTS)

How well does the contestant know about the Louisiana Cattlemen's Association? (Ex. Who the Executive VP is, Current President, and President Elect). What the association does for the cattlemen in Louisiana. How well does the contestant knows about current events going on in our industry today?

PERSONALITY: (1-20 POINTS)

The contestant should be respectful, kind, and sincere. They should be enthusiastic about the industry and what it does for local cattlemen. They should present themselves in a sophisticated way and be able to have a conversation with anyone they may encounter. Remember this person is representing LCA, you should look for leadership qualities in them.

SPEAKING ABILITY: (1-20 POINTS)

The contestant should be able to think quick on their feet but still have accurate information on what they are speaking about. They should also be able to explain themselves in a clear, a concise, and a complete way. The contestant needs to also be able to communicate in a way someone who is not in our industry can understand.

POISE: (1-20 POINTS)

The contestant should be well mannered and approachable. They should present them self in a professional manner. They should also be able stay calm under stressful situations and during difficult conversations with people. She should be aware of the world around her and sit up straight and tall. The contestant should also be able to handle herself in any situation. She should be confident in herself, her knowledge, and abilities.
